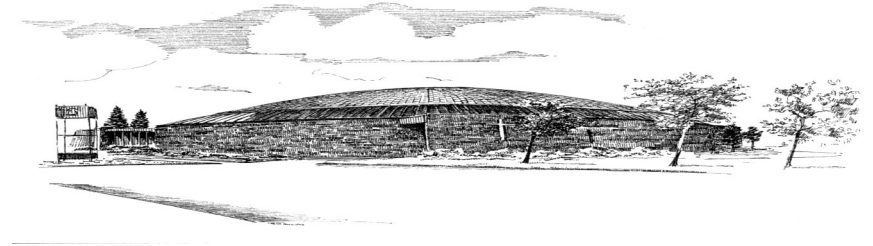
RAINBOWS TRAINING
