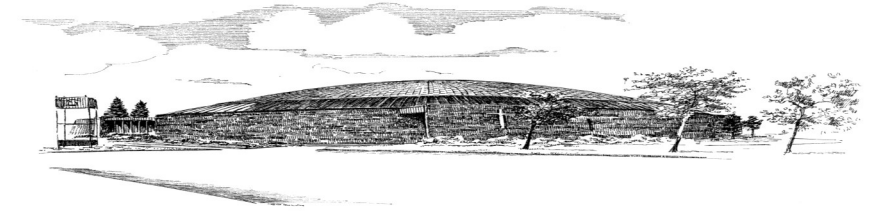

The Season of Creation:

The season of Creation or Creation Time, is marked throughout the Christian world from 1st September to 4th October (Feast of St. Francis of Assisi) and celebrates the joy of creation as well as encouraging awareness-raising initiatives to protect the natural environment.

Pope Francis challenges us to reflect; 'What kind of world do we want to leave to those who come after us, to children who are now growing up?' *Laudato Si 160*

Here in St. Joseph's Parish we are honouring this especially on the weekend of 5th and 6th October at all Masses. The theme for this year's celebration is 'The Web of Life' We are protecting biodiversity in all its wonderful complexity because each member of God's creation reveals a piece of the Creator's glory.

We are inviting Sister Nellie Mc Laughlin to speak to us on this theme at all our Masses on this weekend. Nellie is a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Mercy, Northern Province, Ireland. Sister Nellie works in cosmology, ecology, sustainable living, together with retreats and conferences in creation spirituality throughout Ireland and internationally. She has published several books on the topic. **Sister Nellie will talk with any parishioners, who may wish to take these issues further, after the Saturday Vigil Mass in St. Joseph's Resource Centre. Please come with all your questions.**
