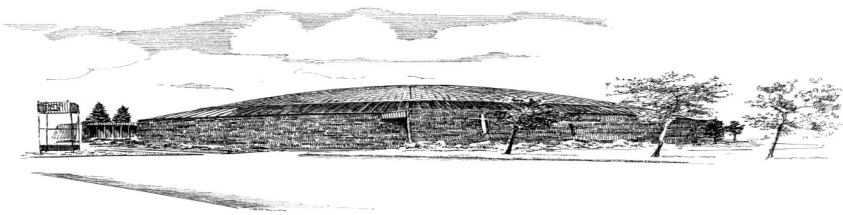

The theme for this year's celebration is 'The Web of Life' We are protecting biodiversity in all its wonderful complexity because each member of God's creation reveals a piece of the Creator's glory.*

We are inviting Sister Nellie Mc Laughlin to speak to us on this theme at all our Masses next weekend. Sister Nellie is a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Mercy, Northern Province, Ireland. Sister Nellie works in cosmology, ecology, sustainable living, together with retreats and conferences in creation spirituality throughout Ireland and internationally. She has published several books on the topic.

**Sister Nellie will talk with any parishioners, who may wish to take these issues further, after the Saturday Vigil Mass in St. Joseph's Resource Centre.**
