### Seeds:

Three steps downwards in sin. It begins with ME... give me .... Me at the centre. Then, gradually the ME – journey goes a distance from our true home: the lost sheep nibbles its way lost.

Finally, the famine is the hunger of discontent, hating what one is doing to self and to others. The story comes to a turning point when he came to his senses. Three steps back up the ladder. First, I will leave this place. Then, I will go to my Father. Finally, I will say, confession of personal responsibility... before God and towards the human family.

Trace the path of the three R words. **Remorse**, literally a biting sorrow, eats away all peace and dignity. **Repent**, literally to think again, to remember God and goodness. **Rejoice** – every sacrament is a celebration of Christ's presence.
