St. Thomas Aquinas, who was one of the greatest theologians in the history of the church, probably answers it best when he said: 'Whenever we speak about God, there is only one thing we can be sure of, that we're wrong'.

Anytime that we gather to celebrate Mass, our Eucharist, the great prayer of thanksgiving, we are always reminded that we are caught up in the mystery of the Trinity.

We are thinking about a mystery and in this life we will never grasp its full meaning, but it is not entirely beyond us.

Some of the best things in life are appreciated rather than understood and that is very much the case when it comes to the Trinity.

Summed up in a few words, the Trinity is God's three ways of being there.
