**5k Fun Walk/Run for Autism:**

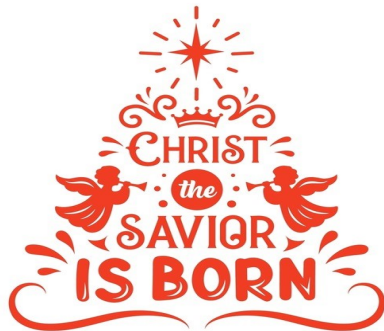
